The Author warrants that his/her contribution is original and that he/she is the sole author and owner of the contribution and has full power to make this grant.
2. The Author and the Press mutually agree that publication of the Author's contribution is contingent upon its acceptance for publication by the editor of the volume and by the Press.
3. The Author guarantees that none of the material included in his/her contribution has been previously published or, if it has been previously published in whole or in part, that he/she has obtained an assignment of copyright in the name of the Arizona Board of Regents. Such assignment shall be submitted with the Author's manuscript.
4. The Press will edit the Work for style, usage, and felicity, in accordance with its usual practice. The Author, or the title-page editor of the volume, as they shall agree between them, shall have an opportunity to read and correct the edited manuscript.
5. The Author will receive no royalty or other monetary return from the University for the use of his/her material, but in lieu thereof he/she will receive one (1) free copy of the published Work. The Author may purchase additional copies of the Work for his/her own use, and not for resale, by direct order from the Press at a 40 percent discount from list price.

If the foregoing terms are satisfactory to you, please sign, date, and return this agreement to the Assistant to the Director at the UA Press. A fully executed copy will be returned to you for your records.
